**A Bill to Create an Ad-Hoc Committee to Report on the Options Available to Improve the Student Services Provided by Printing & Copy Services for the Representative Body**

WHEREAS: The University of Virginia Printing and Copying Services (UVA PCS) currently provides services to students in an efficient and effective manner; AND,

WHEREAS: The student body's need for such services will increase as the enrollment of students increases in the coming years; AND,

WHEREAS: The current PCS printing system has been a recurring topic of concerns from the student body; AND,

WHEREAS: The Student Council has a duty to ensure that the provision of sufficient services to the student body is continued; AND,

WHEREAS: The Student Council must, then, work with UVA PCS to ensure that the provision of printing and copying services are provided in an effective manner to the student body into the future; THEREFORE BE IT,

ENACTED: The Student Council Representative Body forms the "Printing and Copying Partners Committee" (PCPC) as an ad-hoc committee of the Representative Body; AND BE IT FURTHER,

ENACTED: PCPC will be comprised of no more than 3 Student Council Representative Body members to be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the Chair of the Representative Body and no more than 2 members of the Student Council Executive Board or the Student Council Presidential Cabinet to be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the President of the Student Council; AND BE IT FURTHER,

ENACTED: The designated Ex Officio Representative to a Student Council Standing Committee with a substantive connection to the stated goal of PCPC will be drawn from the Academic Affairs Committee of the Student Council; AND BE IT FURTHER,

ENACTED: The Chair of the Representative Body shall appoint a Chair of PCPC from the no more than 5 members previously appointed to PCPC by the Chair of the Representative Body and the President of the Student Council; AND BE IT FURTHER,

ENACTED: PCPC will be tasked with partnering with UVA PCS to report back to the Representative Body on any potential options for improving the provision of printing and copying services and with actively expressing student desires for changes in printing services at the university; AND,



ENACTED: PCPC will either report back to the Student Council General Body on or prior to February 28, 2017 at the pleasure of the Chair of the Representative Body or request, from the Chair of the Representative Body, an extension, not to exceed one calendar year, of the deadline by which a report must be given to the Student Council General Body or another extension must be requested.
